



BURN PERMIT

ISSUED BY THE PORTER FIRE DEPARTMENT

**A PERMIT WILL ONLY BE VALID FOR 10 DAYS OR
AS LONG AS THE BELOW RULES ARE BEING FOLLOWED.**

- 1. The Porter Fire Department reserves the right to deny and or terminate any permits and or fires at any time.**
- 2. The property owner and or the person burning will accept all liability for the fire and any other accidents pertaining to the fire.**
- 3. All State and DEQ requirements oversee this permit.**
- 4. No burning of tires, shingles, batteries, fuels, electric wire, etc.**
- 5. No burning during any state burn ban.**
- 6. No burning on Wednesday or Sunday.**
- 7. No burning before 9:00 AM.**
- 8. No burning after 9:00 PM.**
- 9. No burning of materials outside of the city.**
- 10. No burning if smoke becomes a problem to neighbors.**
- 11. No burning under power lines or near gas meters.**
- 12. No moving the burn pile after inspection has been made.**
- 13. No burning if the wind speed is over 10 m.p.h.**
- 14. If any of the above rules are not followed, you may receive a fine of at least \$500.00.**
