



BURN PERMIT

ISSUED BY THE PORTER FIRE DEPARTMENT

**A PERMIT WILL ONLY BE VALID FOR 10 DAYS OR
AS LONG AS THE BELOW RULES ARE BEING
FOLLOWED**

1. The Porter Fire Department reserves the right to deny and/or terminate any permits or fires at any time.
2. The property owner and/or the person burning will accept all liability for the fire and any other accidents pertaining to the fire.
3. All State and DEQ requirements oversee this permit.
4. No burning of tires, shingles, batteries, fuels, electric wire, etc.
5. No burning during any state burn ban.
6. No burning on Wednesday or Sunday.
7. No burning before 9:00 A.M.
8. No burning after 9:00 P.M.
9. No burning of materials outside of the city.
10. No burning if smoke becomes a problem to neighbors.
11. No burning under power lines or gas meters.
12. No moving the burn pile after inspection has been made
13. No burning if the wind speed is over 10 m.p.h.
14. If any of the above rules are not followed, you may receive a fine of at least \$500.00.
