

ISSUED BY THE PORTER FIRE DEPARTMENT

A PERMIT WILL ONLY BE VALID FOR 10 DAYS OR AS LONG AS THE BELOW RULES ARE BEING FOLLOWED

- 1. The Porter Fire Department reserves the right to deny and/or terminate any permits or fires at any time.
- 2. The property owner and/or the person burning will accept all liability for the fire and any other accidents pertaining to the fire.
- 3. All State and DEQ requirements oversee this permit.
- 4. No burning of tires, shingles, batteries, fuels, electric wire, etc.
- 5. No burning during any state burn ban.
- 6. No burning on Wednesday or Sunday.
- 7. No burning before 9:00 A.M.
- 8. No burning after 9:00 P.M.
- 9. No burning of materials outside of the city.
- 10. No burning if smoke becomes a problem to neighbors.
- 11. No burning under power lines or gas meters.
- 12. No moving the burn pile after inspection has been made
- 13. No burning if the wind speed is over 10 m.p.h.
- 14. If any of the above rules are not followed, you may receive a fine of at least \$500.00.
