

RECONVENED REGULAR MEETING
OF THE TOWN OF PORTER
HELD MONDAY, JULY 11, 2016

The reconvened meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Porter was called to order by Mayor Steve Dickey. Members present were: Richard Keck, Adam Springsted, Matt Moore, Sam Hendrix, and Steve Dickey. A quorum was present.

Others present were: Chris Elliot, Les Young, Carl Stout, and Shirley Herring.

Discussion and possible action concerning proposal from Carl Stout concerning paying deputies for working during Peach Festival. Sheriff Chris Elliot said at the meeting held on Thursday, July 7, 2016, the Board members were presented a plan put together by Carl Stout for Wagoner County to furnish law enforcement services for the Peach Festival. He said according to this plan, the cost to the Town would be \$4,800.00. Sheriff Elliot said since the plan was not presented to the Board until a week before the Peach Festival, it was brought up that the Town did not budget the money for this expense. He said he spoke to the District Attorney about this plan. Sheriff Elliot said it was decided that the Sheriff, the Under Sheriff, Chief Les Young, Lieutenant Carl Stout, and two reserves deputies will work the Peach Festival at no cost to the Town. Sheriff Elliot said the Town or Lions Club will have to hire someone to provide security overnight on Thursday night and Friday night. Chief Les Young said he will work the 5K run. He said he needs to know the course the 5K runners are taking. No action was taken on this item.

Motion was made by Steve Dickey to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Matt Moore. Voted yes: Steve Dickey, Matt Moore, Adam Springsted, Sam Hendrix, and Richard Keck. Voted no: None. Motion carried.
